# • Financial Update - Katye

Reviewed School's Statement of Financial Position, as well as the School's Statement of Activities. YTD, we are running a deficit of 163k, which is on track with (but slightly better than) our planned YTD deficit of 165k. As shared in her update, Kathy Jo recently received a large donation of 85k toward our Annual Fund. This gives us reassurance that we are progressing nicely toward our annual fundraising goal. Overall, we feel good about our current financial position.
